Pupil Premium Funding

In 2011 the Government introduced Pupil Premium Fund to help raise the attainment of disadvantaged children and close the gap between them and their peers. In the 2018/19 financial year, schools received £1,300 for every primary-aged pupil registered as Pupil Premium.

Pupil Premium is initially identified by eligibility for Free School Meals. However, once identified, this funding continues for your child for the next 6 years regardless of your ongoing entitlement to free school meals. Free School Meal entitlement is different to Universal Free School Meals for children in YrR, 1 & 2 as this scheme is not linked to additional funding. It is therefore vital that all pupils who are entitled to Pupil Premium funding are identified as early as possible.

Pupil Premium funding can be allocated if a parent/carer is claiming benefits such as; Income Support, Employment and Support Allowance, Child Tax Credit or Universal Credit for example.

We would like to reassure you that no child is identified as a Pupil Premium child, in any way, in their day to day school life. Additionally, the identification of pupil premium/free school meals does not mean your child necessarily has to eat school meals!
