## **Collective Worship**

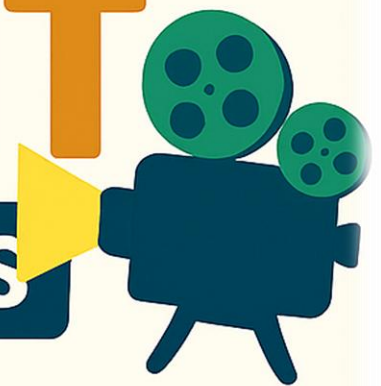
