2. **Choose your child's class.** Scroll to find the correct class and select "Support Campaign".

3. **Join the campaign.** At the top of the page, click "Join this campaign."

4. **Create your account.** Follow the steps to set up an account. Superkind will then email the parent/guardian to verify the account before continuing.

5. **Set up your child's page,** Once the account is verified, your child (or you on their behalf) can log in and create their personal page. They can add a profile picture and personalise it however they like.

6. **Publish the page.** When everything looks right, click publish.

7. **Share the page.** After publishing, you'll be able to share the page via social media, WhatsApp, email, and more. A unique QR code is also provided for easy sharing.
