

### INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT (VARIATION)

1. The name of the school is Ropley Church of England Primary School
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school
3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of Ropley Church of England Primary School"
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. Three parent governors *[at least two parent governors]*
  - b. One local authority governor
  - c. One staff governor
  - d. The Headteacher
  - e. Three co-opted governors *[Such number as the governing body consider necessary. The total number of co-opted governors who are eligible to be elected as staff governors under Schedule 2, when counted with the staff governor and the headteacher, must not exceed one third of the total membership of the governing body]*
  - f. Three foundation governors *[at least two but no more than one quarter of the total]*
5. Total number of governors: Twelve
6. The name of the foundation body entitled to appoint the foundation governors is the Winchester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Parochial Church Council of St Peter's Church, Ropley.
7. (a) the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio;  
The principal officiating minister of St Peter's Church, Ropley.  
  
(b) the Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which this governorship exists.

8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated is entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.

9. There is a trust deed for the school dated 1902.

10. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the church at parish and diocesan level.


