Dear Parents,

As part of our topic this half term on Crime and Punishment, Honeycomb and Beekeeper class will be visiting the Tower of London on Thursday 5th December.

As well as an opportunity to explore the Tower, they children will also be taking part in a Crime and Punishment workshop. As one of the world's most infamous prisons, the Tower of London has seen many people locked within the fortress walls. But who exactly was imprisoned here? And what conditions did they live in? In the workshop, children will put themselves into a prisoner's shoes. A costumed presenter will recount exciting stories from the Tower's dark history, whilst exploring some of the historic spaces originally used to hold prisoners.

Children need to report to the school hall by **7.45am at the latest** so they can be registered. We will be departing from school **at 8.00am** on this day and returning to school between 5pm and 6pm, traffic depending. The children will need to bring a substantial packed lunch that includes a mid morning and mid afternoon snack and a water bottle in a small rucksack which they can carry. If your child normally has school lunches, the kitchen can provide a school packed lunch, please indicate this on the slip below, although we would ask that you also send additional snacks from home to supplement the school packed lunch. All children should wear school uniform and sensible footwear as we will be walking around the Tower.

The cost of the trip will be £21.85 per child. This covers the cost of coach hire, entrance fees and the workshop with the Education Centre. If we do not receive enough payments, this trip will not go ahead. **Payment and permission can be made using your Scopay account.** Please ensure you indicate if you will be providing a home packed lunch or if you require a school packed lunch and, if so, what filling your child would like.

We will require some additional adult support on this trip. If you are available and have a current DBS clearance check, please let the school office know or indicate on the slip below. We will let you know by Monday 2nd December if we need you to come with us. If you make payment and give permission online you do not need to return the slip below but please remember to indicate your lunch choice!
